1. Angelica di Nova Lipa

The submitter's registered name is "of Nova Lipa", and will be adjusted on the external letter.

We do not distinguish the type of fleur-de-lys for registration, regarding it as artistic detail. The blazon has been adjusted accordingly.

"The fleur-de-lys was blazoned on the Lol as florencée. The exact drawing style of fleurs-de-lys is a non-blazonable artistic detail. The submitter is entirely welcome to use a Florentine fleur-de-lys in depictions of her armory." [Amata Amati d'Arezzo. November 2008 via Ansteorra]

2. Catelin Straquhin

Language (Scots or English) most important. Culture (Scots or English) most important. Spelling (Straguhin) most important.

Scottish household names can be formed following the pattern of 'Clan + surname of Lowland family + of + Scottish location', as noted in "Alys's Simple Guide to Household Names" (<u>http://heraldry.sca.org/names/households.html</u>) under Section 2 of 'Household Names Based on Ancestor's Name.'

Straquhin is a variation of the Lowland Scottish surname Strachan that was found in the Aberdeen Council Register in 1533 and 1549, as noted in "Early 16th Century Scottish Lowland Names" (<u>https://medievalscotland.org/scotnames/lowland16/</u>) under the Surnames > Aberdeen Surnames by Instances sub-section. This surname is also previously registered to the submitter, in January 2019 through the East Kingdom.

Dewra is the 1590's name of Jura (header form), an Inner Hebrides island, as found on page 142 of James B. Johnston's "Place names of Scotland" (<u>https://ia802605.us.archive.org/21/items/placenamesofscot00johnuoft/placenamesofscot00johnuoft.pdf</u>).

In kingdom commentary, Alys Ogress noted that she found no real-world association between Clan Strachan and Dewra.

Submitter desires a feminine name.

Freydís is an Old Norse feminine given name found in Nordiskt runnamnslexikon, p. 70, s.n. Frøydīs.

Gerdr is an Old Norse feminine name given name found on p. 9 of Geirr Bassi.

The formation of a matronymic byname replaces the -r ending with -ar, as attested on p. 18 of Geirr Bassi.

Notes:

In kingdom commentary, it was noted that the swirls and darker forehead markings were intended as artistic detail, not as blazonable aspects of the heraldic animal.
